Waltham-based business donates \$29K to homeless coalition

Waltham-based RTN Federal Credit Union presented a check for \$29,000 to the Massachusetts Coalition for the Homeless, proceeds from the credit union's 2014 Walk Home.

Presenting the check to coalition Executive Director Robyn Frost and major gifts director Donna Crotty were RTN Board Chairman Charles L. Doherty, RTN Treasurer and Chief Executive Officer Richard E. Wright, and Senior Vice President of Retail Services Nicole James.

More than 125 walkers and volunteers participated in Walk Home 2014, held June 8 in three communities with RTN branches: Dorchester, Waltham and Danvers. State and local officials who attended included Waltham Mayor Jeannette McCarthy, state Sen. Michael Barrett, state Rep. Thomas Stanley, and Waltham Councilor-at-large Diane LeBlanc.

"RTN is proud of our long and deep commitment to support the Massachusetts Coalition for the Homeless and the important work it does on behalf of individuals and families in Massachusetts who experience homelessness," Doherty said. "We look forward to continuing this support through next year's Walk Home on Sunday, June 14."

Founded in 1945, RTN is one of the largest credit unions in Massachusetts, with \$800 million in assets, 50,000 members and 19 branches, according to the organization.
