**RTN Presents \$22,206 Raised from Walk Home 2013 to  
Mass. Coalition for the Homeless to Help Homeless Teens**

Waltham, MA – RTN Federal Credit Union has presented a check in the amount of \$22,206.75, which were the proceeds of the Walk Home 2013 5K benefit walk for the homeless on Saturday, June 1, 2013. Arthur R. Osborn, Jr., Chairman, RTN's Board of Directors, presented the check to Robyn Frost, Executive Director, Massachusetts Coalition for the Homeless. Also present were Richard E. Nearly 100 walkers and volunteers attended the three 5K Walk Home events, which took place in communities with RTN branches: Greater Boston Walk Home (Dorchester Park); MetroWest Walk Home (Waltham Common); and North Shore Walk Home (Danvers Rail Trail). The funds raised will support the Coalition's theme this year of "Rising to the Top," which is aimed at helping families and individuals rise out of poverty, with a particular emphasis on helping homeless teenagers.

"RTN is proud of our long and deep commitment to support the Coalition and the important work it does on behalf of individuals and families in Massachusetts who experience homelessness," says Arthur R. Osborn, Jr., Chairman, RTN's Board of Directors. "We have donated more than \$100,000 to the Coalition during the past ten years, and we look forward to continuing this support through our annual Walk Home event."
