RTN's Walk Home for Homeless Teens a Success

Waltham, MA— Remarks from Councilor Frank Baker, Representative Marty Walsh, Middlesex County Sheriff Peter Koutoujian, Waltham Mayor Jeannette McCarthy, and Danvers Board of Selectman Chair Gardner Trask, III, kicked off the opening programs of RTN Federal Credit Union's Walk Home held on Saturday, June 1, 2013. The three Walk Home 5K routes took place in communities with RTN branches: Greater Boston Walk Home (Dorchester Park); MetroWest Walk Home (Waltham Common); and North Shore Walk Home (Danvers Rail Trail).

Additional program participants included representatives from the Massachusetts Credit Union League, and from the Massachusetts Coalition for the Homeless, including Executive Director Robyn Frost.

Nearly 100 walkers and volunteers attended the three Walk events. The funds raised will support Massachusetts Coalition for the Homeless. The Coalition's theme this year is "Rising to the Top," which is aimed at helping families and individuals rise out of poverty, with a particular emphasis on helping homeless teenagers.
