



**THE HOUSING 101 TRAINING WALKS YOU THROUGH THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND HOW TO APPLY FOR IT.**

Completing a housing application can be a tedious task. Also, submitting an application without all required documentation could result in an application not being processed correctly.

Our purpose with the Housing 101 is to go into different communities and provide support not only at the moment of completing the application, but also provide applicants with relevant information and answer all their questions and address any barriers that might exist to obtaining housing.

Our goal is to connect the participant with all the low-income housing programs available in their communities, update the applicants' information whenever there is a change of address, family composition or income. We also want to ensure that participants are receiving all benefits for which they are eligible and will apply them for benefits, including SNAP (food stamps), cash assistance, and utility discounts. This initiative works in partnership with different organizations and agencies in Massachusetts to provide support to participants that are experiencing a housing crisis.
